



Healeys on Broadway

Midland & Overseas Centre Weekend
15-17th June 2012

Broadway, Worcestershire

Next year it will be 60 years since the introduction of the Austin Healey 100, and 3 years since the last Midlands & Overseas Centre weekend. For 2012 we are continuing the Cotswolds theme, this time making our base at Broadway, one of the most picturesque towns in the Cotswolds. Our venue will be the Cotswold Conference Centre which offers excellent accommodation and secure parking for our cars. Also on the Sunday, Midlands and National Concours events will be taking place at the centre.

The Cotswold Conference Centre is located between Stratford upon Avon and Cheltenham, and is easily reached from the M5 and the M40 motorways. Set in 370 acres of managed parkland with native woods, meadows and some of the best panoramas in the country.

The event starts on Friday night with a dinner and social evening. This will be a chance to relax, meet up with old friends and make new ones.

Following breakfast on Saturday morning, we set off for Gloucester where we have arranged a guided tour of the city and docks. There will then be a couple of hours in which to have lunch and browse the places of interest before taking a drive back to Broadway. In the evening, there will be a dinner and more socialising.

On Sunday there are two options. Following breakfast there will be a drive to Croome Park, a National Trust property with links back to the RAF and the development of radar during the war. We believe that you will find this an interesting day out and facilities are available for lunch. This will be followed by another fine drive back to Broadway in time for a cream tea with the concours group before saying your goodbyes.

Also on Sunday, the Midlands and National Concours will be held at the conference centre. As an alternative to visiting Croome Park, some may wish to stay at Broadway for the concours, either to enter or to watch the proceedings. For those choosing this option a packed lunch will be provided, and then of course, you will be there to join those returning from the visit to Croome Park for a cream tea later in the day.
